Yarn Wrapped Pumpkins - Quick Guide

Create a donut – twist a piece of burlap or strong fabric into an O shape. This will roughly be the size of your pumpkin.



Wrap – double the yarn and wrap both strands around the O shape holding on to the end loop. Wrap around the loose end to secure it.



Add more – when the thread has run out, pull another strand through the end loop to create another double strand. Keep wrapping.



Tuck in the end – when the pumpkin is fully wrapped, tuck the last end in to secure it. Add a stick to the center.
