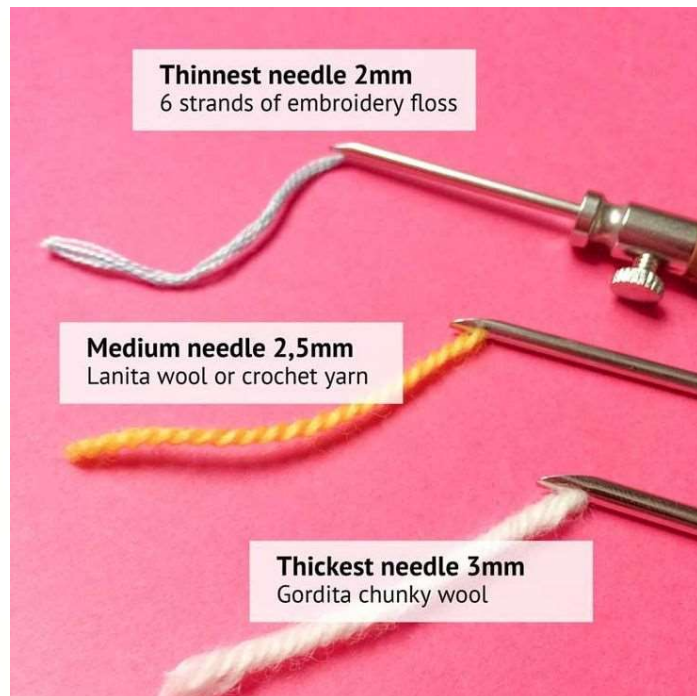
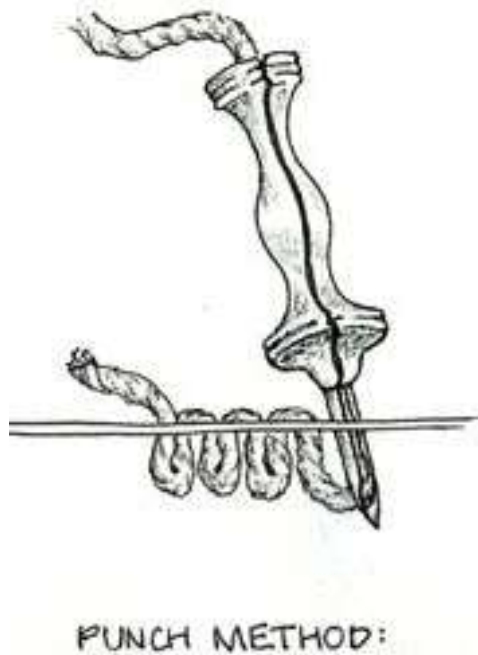


Punch Needle - Quick Guide

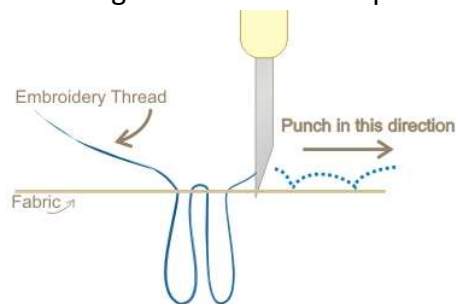
How the punch needle works.

Pick a needle size based on the yarn size you want to use.



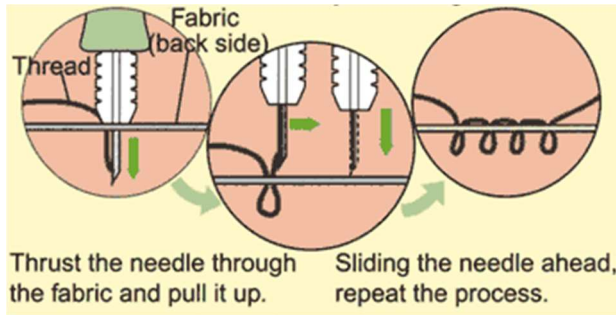
5 tips for easy punch needling

1. **Taut fabric** – fabric should be as tight as possible. Almost like a drum.
2. **Face correct direction** – needle must be facing with the front or open side toward the



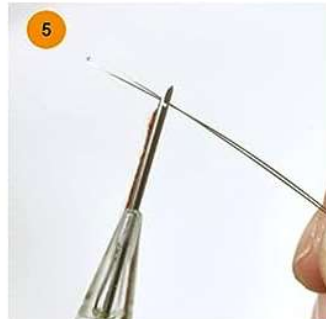
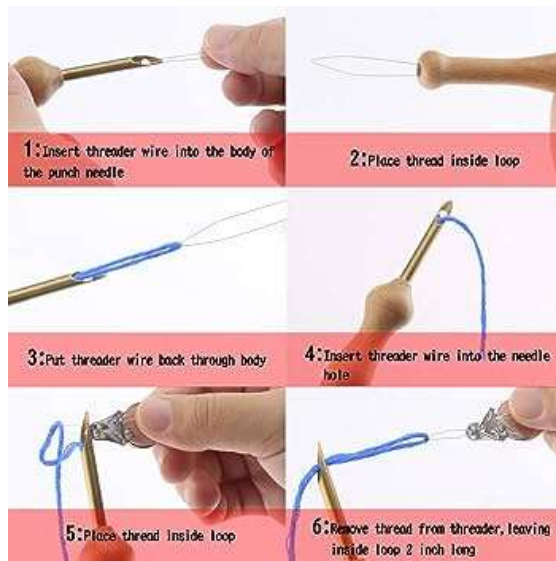
direction you are punching or moving.

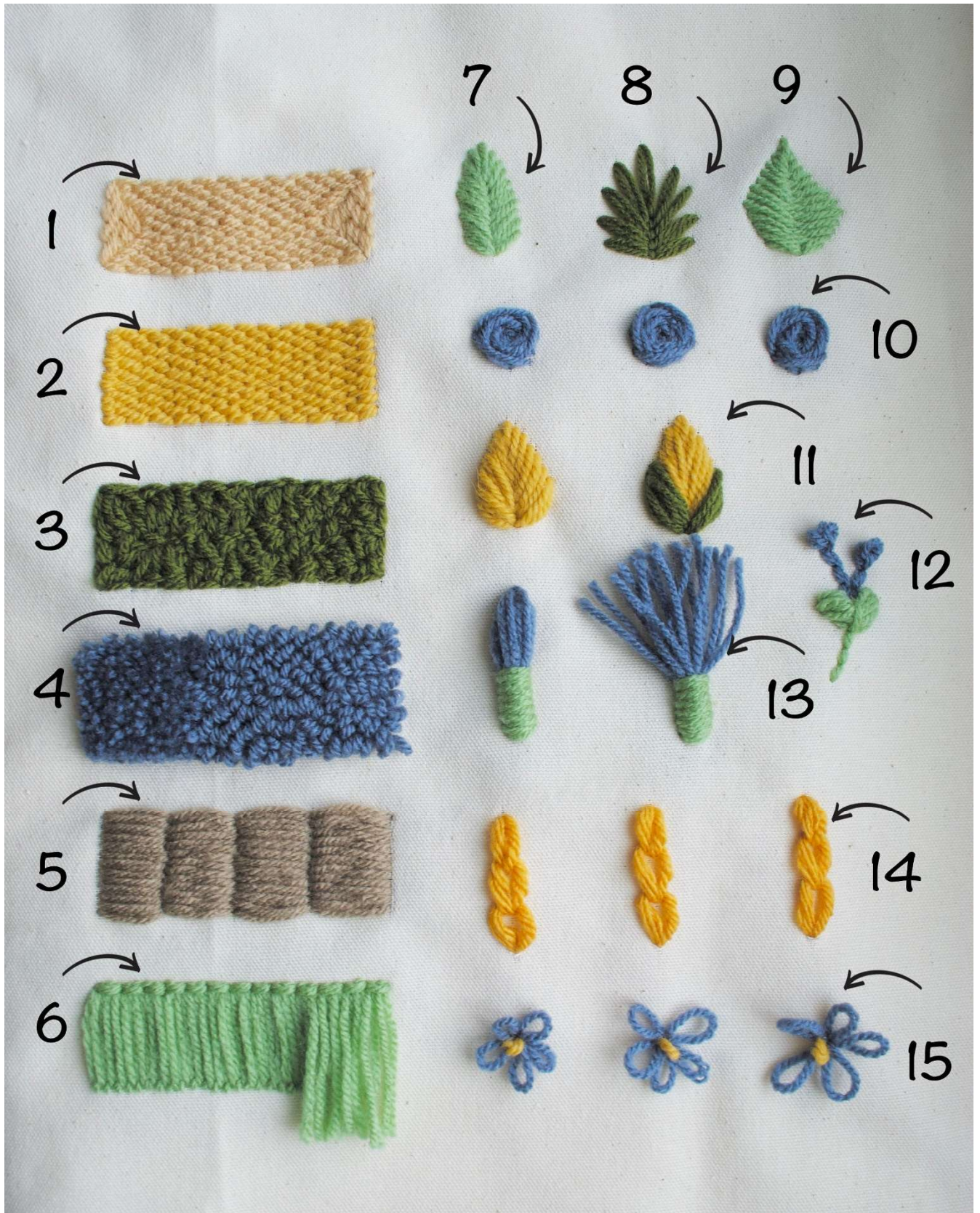
3. **Push down completely** – punch the needle all the way down into the fabric. This will hold the yarn when the needle is pulled back up. If the loop side will be showing on the finished work, punching all the way down each time will ensure the loops are the same size.
4. **Pull up until needle just exits the fabric** – to create consistent stitches keep the tip of your punch needle right along the fabric. Avoid pulling it up above the fabric.



5. **Loose yarn** – make sure the yarn from the ball is loose and freely able to move through the needle.
